Crescent Island Game Sanctuary shores host abundant bird-life especially huge numbers of pelicans cormorants and fish-eagles with their haunting cry.

There are more animals per acre than any other Kenyan Park hence many film companies have been to the Island to film the herds of Wildebeest Waterbuck Zebra and Gazelle.
