

8 Days: Amboseli – Lake Nakuru – Maasai Mara – Lake Naivasha Safari

8-DAYS AMBOSELI LAKE NAKURU MASAI MARA NAIVASHA SAFARI

Day 1: Nairobi-Amboseli National Park

Early morning pick up at your hotel/airport then drive to Amboseli National park, passing through Masai land; to your camp for lunch as well as check-in. Afternoon game viewing starts at 16:00hrs Amboseli National Park, which lies at the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro. Day 2: Amboseli National Park

Spend a whole day in Amboseli National Park, with morning and afternoon game drives. This park is termed as an Animal's paradise. Visit Masai Village and learn their rich culture at an extra cost. Day 3: Amboseli park - Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Morning breakfast Then be driven to Olpejata . Previously known as Sweetwaters, Ol Pejeta is a privatelyowned 90,000 acre wildlife conservancy. Originally a cattle ranch, in some areas you will still see wildlife and cattle grazing happily side by side. The conservancy sits on the equator, high on a plateau, between the foothills of the Aberdares range and Mount Kenya. It hosts a wide variety of animals, including the 'big five', plus many bird species. On a clear day, and normally in the morning, you may have panoramic views of Mt Kenya and her snow-capped peaks. The conservancy has a variety of habitats including thick scrub, marshlands, rivers and open plains. Ol Pejeta is committed to conservation and has a number of projects to protect endangered species, including white and black rhino. They also have a Jane Goodall chimpanzee sanctuary which is home to primates who have been rescued from abusive or captive situations. There are a number of unique experiences which you can add to a safari including a night game drive and lion tracking (booked locally). overnight at **Comfort gardens sweetwaters** https://www.comfortgardens.com/comfortgardens-nanyuki/home



Day 4: Ol pejeta -Lake Nakuru National Park

Depart for Lake Nakuru National Park after breakfast, arriving in time for lunch at the camp as well as check in. Afternoon game drive takes you to the lake to view Flamingos and pelicans. Also, spot White/Black Rhinos, Rothschild Giraffe, Waterbucks and other kinds of African wildlife. The Lake Forest attracts a wide variety of birds. Day 5: Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara National Reserve

Early morning breakfast then drive along the Great Rift Valley, passing by the extinct volcano of Mount Long'onot en route to Masai Mara Game Reserve to the camp for check in as well for lunch. Afternoon game viewing in this fascinating wildlife paradise with a chance to view; giraffes, elephants, monkeys, leopards, lions, gazelles and different bird's species.Overnight at **Explore nature lodge** <u>http://basecampexplorer.com/kenya/hotels/masai-mara</u>



Day 6 : Masai Mara National Reserve

Spend a whole days viewing wildlife in Masai Mara Game reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Have a chance to see the "BIG FIVE": Lion, Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo and Leopard. Wildebeests, Zebras, Cheetahs and Gazelles, other kinds of African wildlife can also be easily spotted. Day 7: Masai Mara-Lake Naivasha

After an early breakfast you will have an early morning game drive and later leave the park. You will head to Lake Naivasha and arrive there in the afternoon. Day 8: sonachi green Crater lake walk-Nairobi

Breakfast will be serve in the early morning and you will be picked up by a driver from 0730am

Then transfer to the Green Crater Lake takes you out of Naivasha and along a rough and bumpy road down the edge of lake Naivasha Passing by huge Greenhouses where roses and other flowers are grown for the export market.

You will arrive at the Green Crater Lake at 8.00am approximately and you will begin your morning game walk. The green crater lake was formed by volcanic activity.

The group will walk in a reserve where its possible to get up close to Giraffe and many varieties of antelope. It is a great opportunity for photos. The guides will answer questions about the animals birdlife etc and point out the rocks formed due to the volcanic activity. Iunch Enroute to Nairobi, Tour ends in Nairobi in the afternoon.
