

Day 1: Arrival in Arusha

Day 2: Arusha City – Lake Manyara National Park – Karatu (165kms) appox 2:30hours

Leave Arusha after breakfast and drive to Lake Manyara national park for full day game drives with packed lunches. Located beneath the cliffs of the Manyara Escarpment, on the edge of the Rift Valley, Lake Manyara National Park offers varied ecosystems, incredible bird life, and breathtaking views. Lake Manyara's famous tree-climbing lions are another reason to pay this park a visit. The only kind of their species in the world, they make the ancient mahogany and elegant acacias their home during the rainy season, and are a well-known but rather rare feature of the northern park. In addition to the lions, the national park is also home to the largest concentration of baboons anywhere in the world a fact that makes for interesting game viewing of large families of the primates you will later proceed to your accommodation in Karatu

Day 3: Karatu – Serengeti National Park (Distance: 170km | Time Taken: 3-4 Hours)

We make the most of the day by departing early in the morning after breakfast with your packed lunch and head off to the Serengeti National Park on a spectacular afternoon game viewing in the Serengeti. It offers an exotic game-viewing experience and great herds of lions, buffalo, elephant, giraffe, and thousands of eland, Topi, Kongoni, impala and Grant's gazelle can be spotted. Later during the day, you will proceed to your accommodation.

Day 6: Ngorongoro Crater Tour – Tarangire National Park (Distance: 135km | Time Taken: 2-3 Hours)

Our driver guide will pick you up and you'll proceed with a game viewing in the Ngorongoro Crater after a breakfast. The largest unfolded and unbroken caldera in the world, Ngorongoro crown is a deep volcanic crater that is diverse and unique. Lions, black rhinoceros, blue wildebeest, Grant's zebras, and many more species can be spotted here. Later, you will be transferred to Tarangire National Park for overnight
