

## 12 Days – Tanzania & Kenya Safari

### Day 1: Arrival

You will be picked up at the airport on your arrival and be taken to the office/hotel for a tour briefing. You will later be dropped at you hotel where you will spend the night before your tour begins on the following day. Overnight at 67 Airport Hotel.

### Day 2: Nairobi-Nakuru (Approximately 3 hours)

You will be picked up at 7:30 am by our tour/guide and immediately depart for lake Nakuru park to arrive by mid-morning. Check in at the resort and have lunch then relax. Later afternoon game. This lake and park is famous for it's flamingos ,endangered white and black rhino but there are other types of animals including lion,girraffes and birds also leaving there.

### **Day 3: Lake Nakuru Park to Masai Mara (approximately 5 hours)**

You will wake up for morning breakfast, Thereafter and drive via Narok town to Maasai Mara National reserve arriving in time for lunch in the campsite. There will be time to settle in before your first game drive. 4.00pm Afternoon game drive in the reserve. Return to the lodge before dark. 7.30pm Dinner in the campsite. ### **Day 4 and 5: Masai Mara full day**

Spend 2 full days with game drives in search of the wild life and the big five. Lion, Cheetah and Leopard roam the vast grasslands in search for their next meal, it may be an unsuspecting impala or even a small one like the warthog...whatever the players, the spectacle of nature unfolding is always awe inspiring!

**Optional activities: hot air Balloon ride, a visit to maasai village and a guided nature walk.**

### **Day 6: Masai Mara - Serengeti National Park**

After breakfast you will transfer to the famous Serengeti National Park via Isebania border with packed lunch. This park is to Tanzania what the Maasai Mara Game Reserve is to Kenya. Covering 14,763 sq km, the Serengeti is dominated by vast, open plains and an abundance of

**Day 7: Serengeti Park full day**

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**Day 8: Serengeti -Ngorongoro Crater (approximately 2-3 hours)**

Transfer to the Ngorongoro crater via Olduvai Gorge. Olduvai Gorge is famous for the discovery of 3.5 million year-old fossil fragments from an early human civilization. Ngorongoro crater is an impressive 20km wide volcanic crater with 600m walls. The views from the crater rim are breathtaking, and there is an ever-present abundance of wildlife due to the permanent water supply on the crater floor with game viewing at crater floor. ### **Day 9: Ngorongoro - Lake Manyara National Park**

Leave ngorongoro after breakfast and drive to Lake Manyara national park for full day game drives with packed lunches. Located beneath the cliffs of the Manyara Escarpment, on the edge of the Rift Valley, Lake Manyara National Park offers varied ecosystems, incredible bird life, and breathtaking views. Lake Manyara's famous tree-climbing lions are another reason to pay this park a visit. The only kind of their species in the world, they make the ancient mahogany and elegant acacias their home during the rainy season, and are a well-known but rather rare feature of the northern park. In addition to the lions, the national park is also home to the largest concentration of baboons anywhere in the world a fact that makes for interesting game viewing of large families of the primates. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**
